BELOW IS A LIST OF DANCE DYMENSION'S 2026 CODE OF CONDUCT EXPECTATIONS. THEY ARE PUT IN PLACE TO ENSURE WE HAVE A HAPPY, SAFE AND FRIENDLY DANCE ENVIRONMENT FOR OUR STUDENTS, THEIR FAMILIES, OUR COMMUNITY AND OUR COACHES. THIS IS AN AGREEMENT THAT DANCE DYMENSION STUDENTS, THEIR FAMILIES AND OUR STAFF ARE AGREEING ON TO PARTICIPATE IN CLASSES AT DANCE DYMENSION IN 2026.

PICK UP AND DROP OFF

We encourage all parents to drive safely around studio parking, please keep an eye out for small children. We encourage quick drop off and pick up when possible to make room for other cars. If parents need to come into the studio they are to wait in reception and are not to sit in classes or around studios. DANCE DYMENSION is not responsible and will not take responsibility for students that arrive before or after their scheduled classes. It is the responsibility of parents to ensure their child is picked up & dropped off on time. In the case of an emergency or delay in picking your child up, please contact 0430139395 so we can update your child and the class teacher to ensure they are aware and safe.

ATTENDANCE

Attendance is important for each individual's progress as well as the class progression. Please make sure you have good class attendance especially in term 4 (concert term). You will not receive a refund if a class is missed.

BEHAVIOUR

WE ARE A BULLY FREE ZONE! We will not tolerate any bullying, aggressive or inappropriate behaviour (including on social media). Should this occur it will be dealt with appropriately. We expect our students and their families to be kind, welcoming and supportive to all DD families and students. We pride ourselves on being a friendly family dance studio. These values are extremely important to us, any students or their families that do not act in this way will be given a warning and a meeting will be arranged. Any physical, mental, emotional or cyber bullying by parents, staff or students will not be tolerated and will result in dismissal from the studio. Polite behaviour and RESPECT towards the teachers and fellow students is expected at all times.

CLASS READY

Please arrive to your class with adequate time to park, get dressed, use bathroom and prepare for class. Please arrive to class in DD appropriate uniform, with appropriate shoes and hair tied up neatly. Please remove jewellery before class (especially cheer classes). Phones to be on silent and in bag.

COMPETITION STUDENTS/ FAMILIES

If you are committing to be a competition student in 2026 you can not miss more than 1 class per term (poor attendance will lead to being asked to leave that team as poor attendance will hold up the progress of yourself as a dancer/cheerleader and your team). You are also committing to being in that team for the whole year, you can not leave until the competition season is over and must be at all competitions. ALL FEES, COSTUMES AND COMPETITION FEES MUST BE PAID FOR ON TIME. Competition students and their families are expected to have respectful and positive attitudes at any competition or performance towards all fellow DD members and other studio/gyms. You are representing Dance Dymension at these events and there is to be no negativity towards our peers or other studio/gyms. Competition students are to train exclusively at Dance Dymension.

LOST PROPERTY

DANCE DYMENSION is NOT responsible for any lost personal items of clothing, jewellery, shoes, money, makeup, school books, iPads, iPods, laptops etc. Please help us return lost items to you by labelling every item with your child's name. Please check lost property if you have left something behind or post on our DD facebook page in case it has ended up in another student's bag.

FEES AND COMMUNICATION

DANCE DYMENSION TERM FEES, COMPETITION FEES AND COSTUME FEES as per enrolment pack must always be paid. Any fees that are late will have a late fee added to them. If you are experiencing difficulties paying your fees please contact our admin to arrange a payment plan. Please make sure when choosing your 2026 classes that it is affordable for your family and budget. Any outstanding fees will be passed on to our debt collecting company. Parents/caregivers are responsible for making sure your accounts are paid and up to date. All missed classes must be still paid for. Where possible your child can do a catch up class. Be sure to regularly check your emails and all social media updates so you are always up to date with all our communications.

STUDIO

Dancers must treat the studio, coaches and fellow students with respect and kindness. Clean up all messes and throw out any food or garbage in the many bins provided and respect all studio areas and equipment. Parents are to ensure siblings are supervised at all times, equipment is treated with care and the waiting areas are left tidy. No swearing or foul language is to be used at the studio. No classes or teachers are to be disturbed during classes unless it is an emergency. Our class time is very precious and we want to give all our focus to our students. NO SMOKING OR ALCOHOL anywhere on the premises

ADDITIONALS

DANCE DYMENSION reserves the rights to change timetable, staff and coaches if necessary. DANCE DYMENSION reserves the rights to ask a student / family to leave if students or their families fail to follow our code of conduct, fail to pay fees, costumes or competition fees. Students or parents are not permitted to take video or photos of students in classes for the safety of our students. Class teachers will take videos of choreography to post on team pages for students to practice. Dance Dymension staff will take photos/videos that will be shared on our social media accounts you must let us know if you do not want your child in any of these. All Dance Dymension choreography, class plans, costuming, remain the property of DANCE DYMENSION and may not be reproduced or sold. Should students hope to use Dance Dymension routines or choreography for outside events eg school talent quest, school disco, outside performance etc request must be made to studio admin. Dance Dymension is a safe space for children and will report and take action if a child is at harm or in case

DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS :

Inappropriate, disrespectful or aggressive behaviour by students, parents (including carers or legal guardians), extended friends and family, staff or volunteers will not be tolerated and may result in immediate cancellation of enrolment with no refund or further discussion or immediate termination of employment or contract.

A breach of the Code of Conduct will result in one written warning. Further breaches may result in immediate cancellation of enrolment with no refund or further discussion or immediate termination of employment or contract. Dance Dymension is a Child Safe environment committed to understanding and abiding by the NSW Government Child Safe Standards. Our studio is a child-safe environment. Staff are mandatory reporters and must and will report any concerns regarding a child's safety or wellbeing to the appropriate authorities.
